Student:

Parent/Guardian:

Expect that their daughter will be provided with high quality specialist music tuition by the music teacher in return for payment of tuition fees.

Acknowledge that they are responsible for ensuring that their daughter attends all lessons. If their daughter is absent from a lesson, the parent/guardian will be charged a fee of \$10 per lesson. The parent/guardian will also be responsible for ensuring that their daughter is prepared for lessons.

Lessons missed due to unplanned absence by their daughter such as illness will not be made up by the music teacher but the parent/guardian will be charged a fee of \$10 per lesson. The parent/guardian will also be responsible for ensuring that their daughter is prepared for lessons.
