BAPTISM and ADMISSION TO HOLY COMMUNION

In Religious and Values Education (RVE) the girls in Year 4 will be learning about the sacraments of the Church, particularly Baptism and Holy Communion.

On Wednesday 28 April at 6.00 pm, the Primary Year 4-6 Family Service will be held at the school. It will be a service of Holy Communion and any member of the school community from **Year 4 and above** who would like to be formally welcomed to receive bread and wine is invited to complete the attached form. The prerequisite is that you have already been **baptised**. There will be an opportunity to be baptised during this service prior to being admitted to communion, for any girls who wish to be baptised at school.

Girls who are already communicant members of their own Christian denominations and are baptised (christened) in their own traditions are not required to be admitted to either sacrament anew. They will be invited to take communion whenever the Eucharist is celebrated at school.
